The NDA Process

What is an NDA?

- An **NDA** or **Non-disclosure Agreement** is a contract you sign with Infineon to officially accept the confidentiality of information made available to you. It includes:
 - The names of the parties to the agreement
 - The time period of the agreement
 - What constitutes confidential information
 - Appropriate uses of the information to be revealed
 - Other provisions

When do I need an NDA?

- An NDA is required for getting access to the following documentations:
 - AURIX™ TC3xx documentation
 - HSM documentation (all)
 - AURIX™ TC4xx documentation
 - Traveo™ Documentation
 - PSoC® Documentation

How can I sign an NDA if I do not have one?

- If your company does not have a NDA with Infineon and you are interested in signing it with us, please add the following information in your **email**:
 - Exact company name (incl. legal form)
 - Contact person (Full name)
 - Contact Email Address
 - Contact Phone Number
 - Company Address (with postal code)

- If your company is a **Chinese company**, please add the following information in your email:
 - Company Name (In English)
 - *Company Name (In Chinese)*
 - *Company Reg. No*
 - Company Address (with postal code)
 - Company Profile
